New range of Hydrangea with natural self-branching and minimal vernalization required to induce flowers. Extra large flowers appear on compact plants with very strong flower stems and no support is required.

Recommendations / Growing guidelines

- Prevent powdery mildew with regular treatments
- Under extremely hot conditions a shadow net is recommended for better growing.

Propagation

- Propagation is in late spring/early summer when plants are actively producing new shoots.
- If necessary remove flower heads to promote more vegetative growth.
- Very small tip-cuttings are best, but node cuttings work just as well (see below photo). These root quickly and can be potted grown & pinched over summer before flower bud initiation in late summer, after which you cannot prune or you will lose the flower buds.
